➤ Consent refers to the provision of approval or agreement, particularly and especially after thoughtful consideration and understanding ➤ As per jurisprudence prior provision of consent signifies a possible defense (justification) against civil or criminal liability by the doctor.

➤ Practitioners who use this defense claim that they should not be held liable for a tort or a crime, as the consequence in question occurred with the prior consent and permission of the patient without realising whether it is a commission or an omission and the extent of negligence.
